

Located 3.5 hours north of Toronto and 4 hours west of Ottawa, North Bay is centrally located at the crossroads of Highway 11 North/South and Trans Canada Highway 17 East/West. Experience the Outdoors

North Bay is truly a four season community, with activities available for all interests and all age groups.

North Bay is home to over 100 km of all-purpose trails that wind through the city and connect to trails from surrounding areas. The Laurentian Ski Hill is located in the core of the city and Nordic Ski Club offers over 50 km of groomed cross country skiing and snowshoeing trails.

With access to six marinas, 43 beaches, 74 park areas and 8 golf courses within driving distances, you will never be far from a unique outdoor experience.

Lake Nipissing is home to over 40 fish species and attracts anglers from all over the country. Lake Nipissing covers more than 850 km² and is the 4th largest inland lake in Ontario.

Trout Lake

11 kms long and 4 kms wide, Trout Lake is the source of the Mattawa River and a significant body of water on a wellknown historic North American voyageur route. It also has the distinction of supplying some of the best drinking water in the province.

Family Fun in the Heart of the City

- The Heritage Railway & Carousel Company provides hours of laughter and enjoyment to the more than 100,000 visitors each summer, who stop by to ride the beautiful carousel and miniature railway at North Bay's Waterfront Park.
- The North Bay Capitol Centre is North Bay's historic home for arts and entertainment since 1929. This long-standing entertainment centre, with seating capacity for over 1,000, features regular theatre performances, concerts and is the home to the North Bay Symphony. The Capitol Centre is the only performing arts facility of this size north of Barrie.
- If you are looking for a nice stroll, take a walk on the Lake Nipissing Boardwalk. It is a beautiful paved boardwalk/ pathway that stretches along Memorial Drive and is framed with lovely flower gardens. Incentives

NBRHC aims to make physicians transition into practice as smooth as possible. We offer competitive incentive packages for physicians looking to relocate to North Bay which include a **\$25,000 interest free loan** for terms of five years and funding assistance with moving expenses.

Family Physicians

An **additional \$25,000** is available to Family Physicians setting up a practice through the City of North Bay Practice Start-Up Grant.

North Bay is designated as underserviced by the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care, and for services that qualify, physicians are eligible for the Ministry's one-time **incentive grant of \$83,000**.
