Job Description

The NBRHC Service of Obstetrics & Gynecology is an innovative, efficient and collegial service that is looking for an Obstetrician/Gynecologist to join its team. As designated Level II prenatal community based hospital, the service manages the obstetrical unit (average 930 deliveries/annually) and generalist obstetrical cases. Typical gynecological caseload includes laparoscopic hysterectomies, routine prolapse repairs, hysteroscopies, etc.

The successful candidate will have assigned resources available including Operating Room, ACU clinic time and will participate in the OB/Gyn on-call roster 1:5.

Applicants are required to be certified by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and must be licensed (or eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario. The organization is an affiliated academic teaching centre with NOSM University. The preferred candidate would be expected to participate in teaching undergraduates and postgraduate medical learners.
