



Critical Care Specialists

North Bay Regional Health Centre is seeking Critical Care Specialists interested in practicing medicine in beautiful Northern Ontario.

Description of Service:

The Critical Care Unit (CCU) physician team is responsible for the primary intensive care and ventilatory management of patients admitted to the 16 bed CCU. This service is supported by physician assistants during daytime hours along with a multidisciplinary team including respiratory therapy and a dedicated CCU pharmacist.

North Bay CCU physicians provide consultation to the emergency department and Criticall coverage for the Nipissing Region.

Full-time active staff membership of the CCU service is currently provided by one Intensivist/Emergency Physician (delivering comprehensive care) as well as 2 General Internists and 7 subspecialists (including Cardiology, Respirology, GI, Nephrology and Endocrinology), who provide critical care with support from anesthesia for ventilation care.

Qualifications:

 Qualified applicants will have licensure to practice independently in Ontario and a standing Critical Care fellowship from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.

Remuneration:

- Physicians are competitively remunerated through a combination of fee-for service billings, a lucrative Northern Specialist Alternative Payment Plan & Hospital On-Call Stipends.
- NBRHC offers a Recruitment Incentive Package which includes a \$25,000 recruitment incentive, \$25,000 practice start-up grant, assistance with moving expenses and up to \$94,000 through the Northern Rural Recruitment and Retention Initiative (NRRRI).
