Description of Service: Locum IM physicians will provide consultation to the emergency department and to the hospitalist/ adult family medicine, psychiatric and surgical services under which patients are admitted. Physician assistants offer support during daytime hours. Current full-time active staff membership of the internal medicine service is comprised of 3 General Internists and 7 subspecialists (including Cardiology, Respirology, GI, Nephrology and Endocrinology).

Our Organization: The North Bay Regional Health Centre, constructed in 2011, is a 480 bed health care organization with acute care services including a 24/7 emergency department, 16 bed Critical Care Unit, inpatient adult and pediatric medicine, dialysis, endoscopy and bronchoscopy services, obstetrics, pathology and surgical subspecialties to the surrounding catchment areas of Mattawa, West Nipissing and Temiskaming.
